

We have attempted to present as complete a listing as possible, in chronological order, of the editions, translations, and reconstructions that have been made of the full text of the *Apostolic Tradition*, but have limited the list of secondary literature almost entirely to those studies that are primarily concerned with the *Apostolic Tradition* itself and not with other aspects of Hippolytus's life and works or with early liturgical practice in general.
