## 2 ANNUAL REPORTS OF THE CRIMINAL INJURIES COMPENSATION AUTHORITY (CICA) AND THE CRIMINAL INJURIES COMPENSATION APPEALS PANEL (CICAP)

In describing the application of the 2012 Scheme's provisions, the text refers for illustrative purposes to decisions reached by the CICA. These will be references to the end date of the financial year to which the relevant Annual Report and Accounts refers, irrespective of the date of publication. For example, CICA (2004) refers to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority's Eighth Report: *Annual Report and Accounts 2003/04* (House of Commons Paper 1196, June 2006).

Appeals from the CICA have since 2008 been heard by the First-tier Tribunal, replacing the Criminal Injuries Compensation Appeal Panel. Where the text refers for illustrative purposes to CICAP's decisions, they are identified by reference to the end date of the financial year to which the relevant Annual Report and Accounts refers, irrespective of the date of publication. For example, CICAP (1999) refers to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Appeal Panel's Third Report, *Annual Report and Accounts for the year ended 31 March 1999* (Cm 4670, April 2000).

Chapters 1–6 also occasionally refer to decisions of the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board made under the common law Scheme. These are identified in the text by reference to its annual report, Command Paper, and year of publication; for example, CICB, 24th Report (Cm 536 1988).
