Yasser Seirawan reached a peak ranking of 10th in the world, and was one of the strongest chess players in the USA for several decades. He twice qualified as a candidate for the World Championship title – the first American to do so since Bobby Fischer. A four-time US Champion, Seirawan was also the 1986 Western Hemisphere Champion and a ten-time member of the US Chess Olympiad team. He is one of only a handful of players to defeat World Champions Garry Kasparov and Anatoly Karpov in tournament play. These days he mainly appears as a chess commentator, a role in which his outstanding chess knowledge and engaging manner distinguish him as one of the best in the business.
