

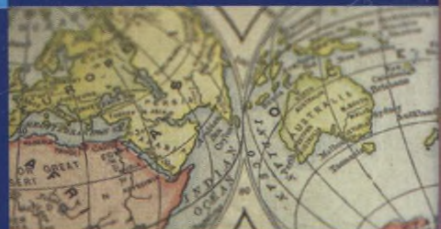
# World Place-Names
