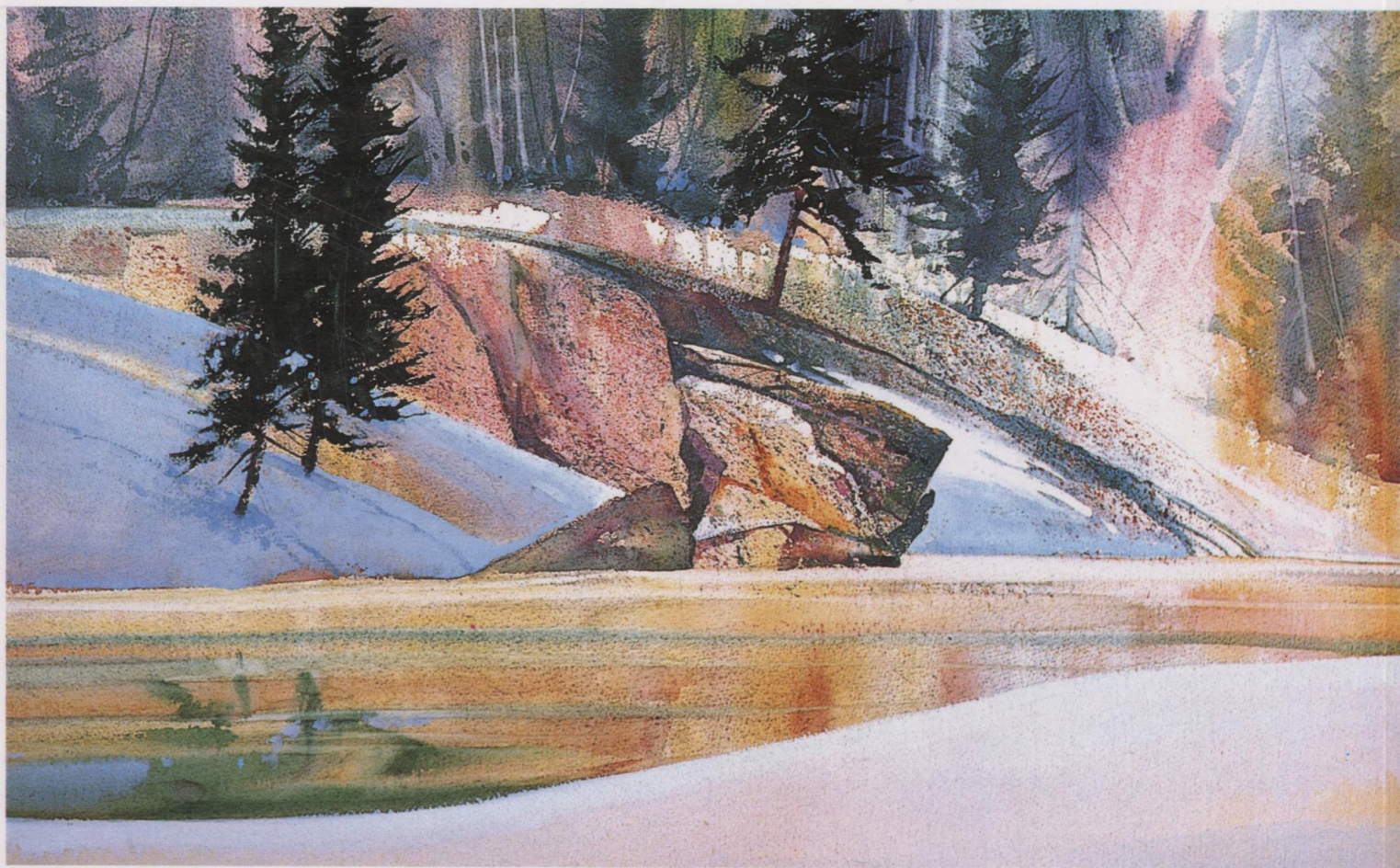


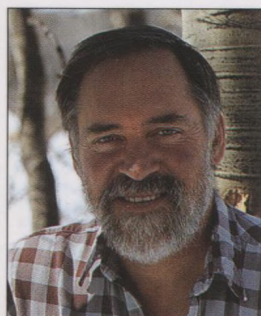
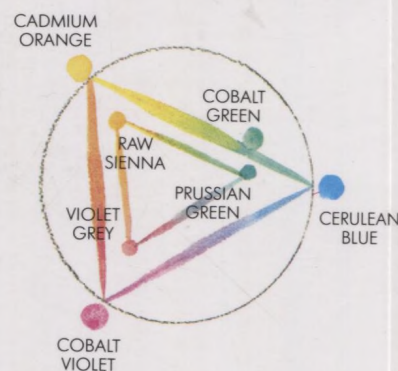
DEVELOP YOUR SENSE OF COLOR



This painting by Stephen Quiller—one of dozens in *Color Choices*—illustrates what can be done with a triadic color scheme. The accompanying circular diagram identifies the specific colors used. It also shows how those colors were chosen and relates them to the Quiller Wheel, the author's precise guide to planning harmonious color relationships.

A personal color sense is a wonderful asset. It enables an artist to express subtle shades of feeling through color, to apply just the right hue intuitively. If you—like most other people—wish you could use color more effectively, *Color Choices* is for you.

A unique feature of this book is the Quiller Wheel: a special fold-out color wheel designed by author Stephen Quiller. No other wheel provides so much useful information. Finally taking the guesswork out of mixing colors, the Quiller Wheel demonstrates how to interpret color relationships and mix colors more clearly—in any medium. Quiller then explains, step by step, how to develop and master five structured color schemes, apply underlays and overlays, and use color in striking, unusual ways. This book—with text that has been newly updated for this paperback edition—will bring out every artist's unique sense of color, whether you work in oil, watercolor, acrylic, colored pencil, gouache, casein, or pastel.



Stephen Quiller is an internationally recognized artist, author, and instructor whose paintings are represented in many corporate, public, and private collections. He teaches workshops throughout the world, juries shows, and lectures on color and water media to art associations and watercolor societies throughout the United States. His other Watson-Guption books include *Acrylic Painting Techniques* and *Painter's Guide to Color*.
