Analysing environmental justice: some conclusions There is value in understanding exactly how social differentiation exists and how it is experienced in environmental terms 215 Environmental inequalities are constituted by more than spatial patterns of proximity and exposure 216 Recognising the methodological complexities and choices involved in generating empirical evidence is important in progressing understanding and in doing justice 216 It is necessary to distinguish between inequality and injustice and to reason carefully about why an inequality matters and to whom 217 Environmental justice is about more than just patterns of distribution; procedure, recognition and their detail, also matter 218 Environmental justice is contested and involves political challenges 219 Environmental justice is an objective but also a process of 'working towards' 220
