



**CHESS RECORDS** is rightly synonymous with the blues, the music that made its reputation. Muddy Waters was the first of the bona fide legends to record for Chess in the late 1940s, helping to shape electric blues/rhythm & blues and what would become rock & roll the following decade with the unprecedented power and sheer unalloyed soul of his work. This 40-track collection (complete with 28-page booklet full of rare photos and authoritative notes) spans his whole career with the label and features influential classics, little-compiled rarities, the choicest cuts from his Grammy-laden album output between 1960 and 1975 and enough certified blues standards to keep disciples and imitators in business for a lifetime!
