Primary Geography is a comprehensive six-book series covering the geography curriculum for 1st to 6th classes.

Primary Geography enables teachers to bring the wider world into the classroom by studying local, national and global issues through a range of engaging learning activities. Through an exploration of the different topics in each book pupils acquire the skills to carry out geographical enquiry through investigation, analysis and practical work.
