

Oxford Caribbean Student's Atlas

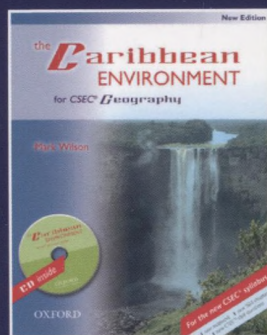
An accessible and informative atlas for Caribbean schools

It includes:

- stimulating satellite images and photographs that provide a sense of place
- a collection of local practice maps
- a section about the School-Based Assessment.

The atlas is provided with a CD containing the maps of the Caribbean, the satellite images, outline maps, and activities and exam-style questions using the practice maps.



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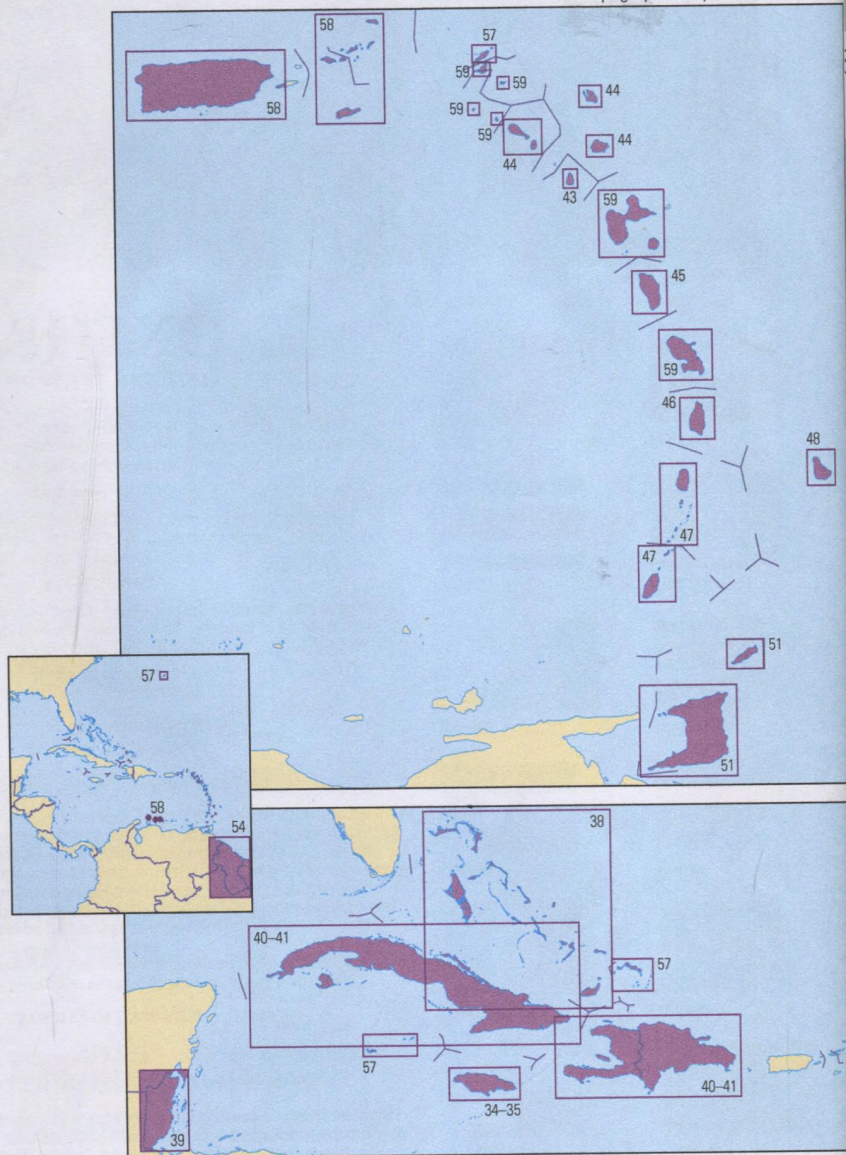
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topographic maps of the Caribbean



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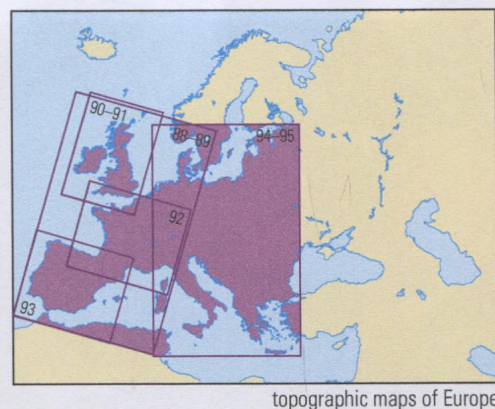
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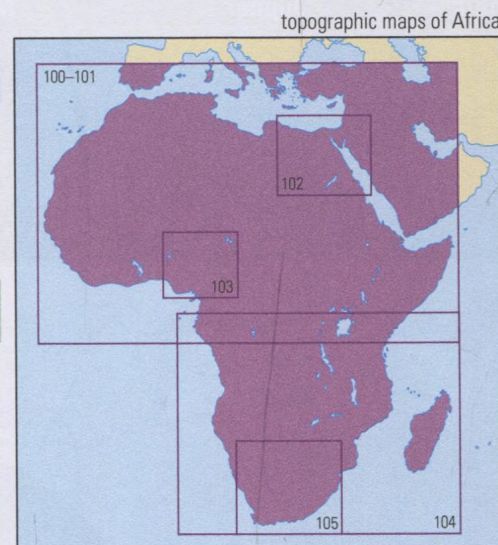
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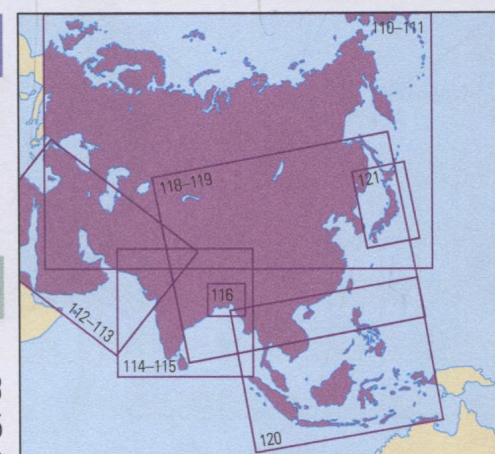
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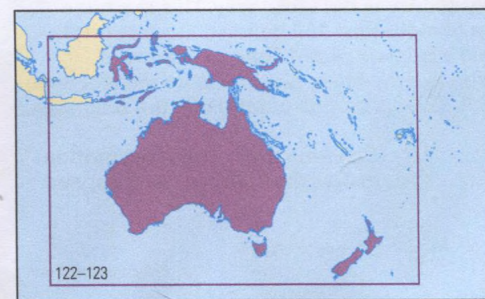
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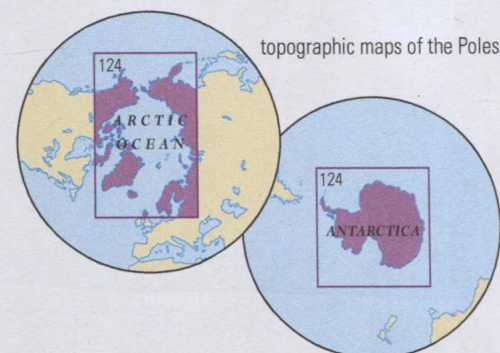
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
