

eorge Gershwin produced melodies the way an apple tree bears fruit — naturally, prolifically, inevitably. One of Broadway's most celebrated composers before he was out of his teens, Gershwin used to say that he had more tunes in his head than he could ever put on paper. In his short, driven life, he wrote hundreds of songs, as well as some of the world's most popular orchestral

pieces ("Rhapsody In Blue" and "An American In Paris") and a path-breaking opera, *Porgy and Bess.* Gershwin was the first – and perhaps the greatest – "crossover" artist; his vibrant, inspired, exuberantly diverse music combined great melodies and classical stylings with the syncopated rhythms and forceful energy of jazz. No wonder he influenced artists ranging from Leonard Bernstein and Miles Davis to Paul Simon and Diane Warren, who pays tribute to Gershwin with an essay. *The Essential George Gershwin* celebrates a man who continues to inspire musicians – and listeners – anywhere his music is played.
