Deep Purple Mk 2's final months together found them delivering a powerful, intense and dramatic studio album. Yet beneath the band's remarkable success lay intense personal differences which tore the group apart just three months after "Who Do We Think We Are" was issued in March 1973. This digitally remastered edition of the album also includes out-takes, unissued material, new mixes and a lengthy studio jam. The illustrated 24 page booklet which accompanies the CD relates the events leading up to the recording sessions in Italy and Germany and includes a personal history by bassist Roger Glover.
