In the case of Shakespeare's plays, however, the modern title is not given, but the original title is used, though there are some exceptions. In the case of the King James Bible, the title is given in both forms, and the original title is also given in full. The title of the First Folio of the plays will be used, and the title of the First Folio of the King James Bible will be used.

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
