

# Alfred's Premier Piano Course

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Level 2A continues the steady development of artistry and keyboard skills that began in 1A and continued through 1B.

- Note-reading skills are expanded to include treble notes E, F and G. Melodic and harmonic 6ths are used to help the student move freely around the keyboard.
- Eighth-note rhythm patterns are added to other rhythms of gradually increasing complexity.
- Technical *Workouts* continue the development of skills for playing hands together, hand-over-hand crossings and finger crossings.

Lesson Book 2A is designed to correlate with Theory and Performance Books 2A of Alfred's Premier Piano Course. When used together, they offer a fully integrated and unparalleled comprehensive approach to piano instruction.

To provide a performance model and a practice companion, a compact disc recording is included with the book. Each title is performed twice on acoustic piano—a *performance* tempo and a slower *practice* tempo.
