

Regarded as France's national chanteuse, singer, songwriter and actress Édith Piaf (1915-1963) also became one of the country's greatest international stars. Her music was often autobiographical with her songs reflecting her life. Piaf's specialties were the chanson and torch ballads, particularly of love, loss and sorrow.
