To follow her acclaimed DG debut featuring Beethoven's Violin Concerto (*Gramophone*: "What a player, and what a way to launch a recording career!"), María Dueñas has chosen Nicolò Paganini's iconic solo *Caprices*. These dazzling gems have accompanied the Spanish rising star since she began playing. Noting



that Paganini lived in the age of Italian bel canto, she seeks "to bring out the vocal quality in the Caprices – to reveal the music behind the technique". Also in this 2-CD album, María Dueñas is joined by other outstanding musicians to perform violin caprices by composers whom Paganini inspired.
