The Implications of the Alphabet Ruling of the Court of Justice of the European Union for the Regulation of Online Digital Markets 252

The CJEU establishes in this landmark ruling that the arbitrary refusal by a dominant online gatekeeper to grant third party access to its platform is an abuse of dominance unless objectively justified. It builds on its previous ruling that self-referencing by a dominant online gatekeeper can constitute an abuse of dominance in digital markets. The ruling provides guidance for gatekeepers and competition authorities on how the Court will interpret the Digital Markets Act.

Australian Merger Control in 2026 and Beyond: A Book of Changes 262

This article examines historic amendments transforming Australia's merger system from a voluntary model to a mandatory, administrative model. These changes aim to address rising market concentration, fears of "gaming" by merging parties, and concerns about the difficulty of proving court cases based on forward-looking narratives. The article suggests the reforms will incrementally tip the scales toward more stringent merger control in Australia.
