As well as the classical and baroque periods, this book also contains music from the swing age and pop era. Maybe the names of the different styles are not familiar to you, but this book introduces them in a playful way. You will encounter well-known composers like Beethoven, Mozart and Bach, but also compositions in a popular, modern style. If a certain style appeals to you, you could try to find other similar material, such as CD recordings.

There is a separate book available with a piano accompaniment – edition number 1023132 – which means you can play these pieces in a concert, a solo recital or even an exam!

You should know that the pieces in this book have been written especially for your instrument. This means that you can't use this book together with other instrumental books from the same series.
